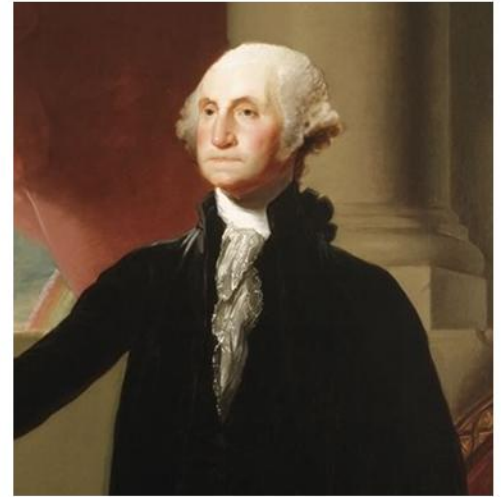


Mrs. Asa Waters Honors the Centennial of General Washington's Birthday

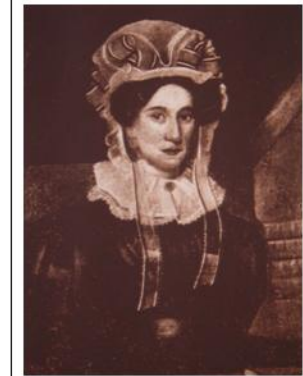
