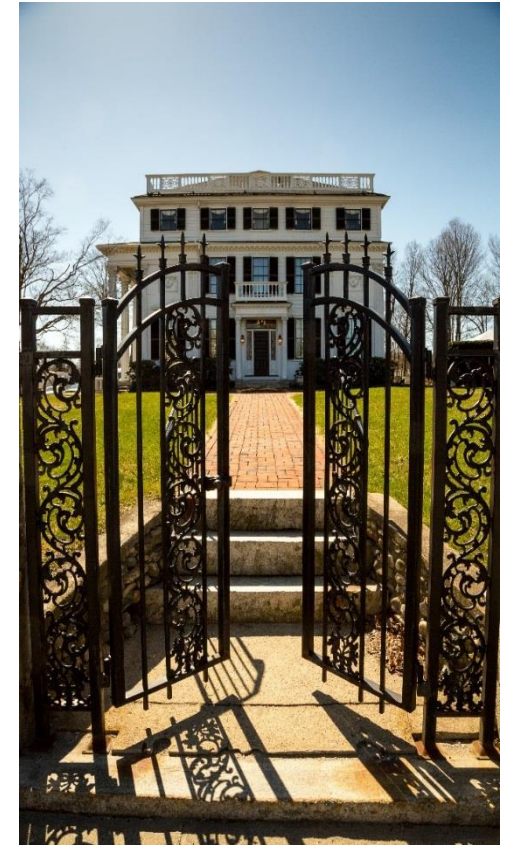

Why become a member?

In 1826, Asa Waters II set out to build a house without equal in the Blackstone River Valley. Sparing no expense, materials were brought in from Italy, Central America and throughout the Eastern US coast to complete the vision. Originally designed to be a house for entertaining, it was finished in 1829. Notables of the time visited the house such as Henry Clay, Abby Kelley Foster, Alexander Graham Bell, Frederick Douglas, Daniel Webster, and Horace Greeley, to name a few. The house has undergone many purposes over the years. Ultimately faced with being razed, the Asa Waters Task Force and Friends of Asa Waters Mansion were formed to save this venerable hall so that it may be continue to be a "jewel" of the region and an asset to the citizens of the Town of Millbury as well as the Blackstone Valley.

Today, the mansion is still used to entertain. It is used for concerts, weddings, classes, tours and lectures. Through our members support, we are able to offer a wide variety of programs to appeal to all ages and areas of interest, including our free events.
